What a difference 24 hours makes! Monday, South Bay residents sat nervously and read that Toyota USA will be packing up and moving their headquarters and over 4,000 jobs to Plano, Texas! In 2006, California lost Carson based Nissan and 4,000 jobs to Nashville! When will California legislators wake up and realize that there are nearly 38 million people living in our state — but, the quality of life is going to be touch and go without good paying jobs?!?

The good news: this early morning at around 1:00 a.m. in front of hundreds at the Carson community center... Mayor Jim Dear, with the support of council member Elito Santarina, succeeded in ending the moratorium to ban reliable and environmentally friendly natural gas production within the city of Carson.
